2020 SHAWANO COUNTY FAIR – FARM TRACTOR RULES 2 Eliminators are used.

- 1. <u>All driver, owners and tractors must reside in Shawano County</u> (excluding Antiques & Open Class). Prize Money will be held until found legal if protested.
- 2. All tractors will be weighed before the pull maximum of 2 weigh-in's for legal weight per class and must reweigh before Line-up to pull. Antiques first weigh in and first to pull at 6:30 p.m. While on the scale, the drawbar will be measured. All tractors must weigh in at the Shawano County Fairgrounds. (TRACTORS TO BE WEIGHED IN FROM 3:00 TO 6:15 p.m.) Be on time or you can not enter. ENTRIES CLOSE AT 6:15 p.m. SHARP!!!
 - 3. All pulls start with a tight hookup. No jerking allowed. All tractors must have a clevis to hook on to. If clevis breaks, you are disqualified.
 - 4. Any modifications used on a daily basis for farming will be permitted.
 - 5. Speed must be controlled by throttle. Stock RPM is in all Farm & Antique classes.
 - 6. Drawbar height no to exceed 20 inches in Class A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, K & L and 21 inches in Class M, N & O and must be 18 inches minimum from center axle to hooking point.
 - 7. All weights must be safely secured to the tractor & must not interfere with hookup to eliminator. Any ballast or external parts lost while hooked to the sled will be cause for disqualification.
 - 8. No weights may extend more than 24 inches in front of tractor.
 - 9. Tractors must be equipped with 4 wheels, <u>a hood, fenders and a grill.</u> It must look like a farm tractor. Use of 4-WD in Class O and P only.
 - 10. Tractors must be equipped with workable rear wheel brakes.
 - 11. Tractors must be regular stock model with stock block engine and are subject to being pumped.
 - 12. ALL MINORS UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE MUST HAVE WRITTEN AND SIGNED CONSENT OF PARENT OR GUARDIAN TO ENTER THE PULL. OFFICIAL MINOR RELEASE FORMS ARE AVAILABLE AT THE FAIR OFFICE. FORMS MUST BE FILLED OUT COMPLETELY ON BOTH SIDES, SIGNED BY PARENT OR GUARDIAN AND MINOR PARTICIPANT. MUST BE 14 YEARS OLD TO ENTER PULL.
 - 13. The use of Torque converters, automatic shifts, etc. will be permitted.
 - 14. Operators must remain seated during pull, must not be intoxicated and conduct themselves in an adult manner. No riders on tractors in pit area.
 - 15. Operator will be allowed 50 feet to stop and shift.
 - 16. Tractors must be stopped immediately upon signal from judge. The pull is over when forward motion of the load stops.
 - 17. Tractors and eliminator must remain within lines during the pull.
 - 18. Tractors may be entered in no more than one class.
 - 19. Antique tractors pull in one antique class only.
 - 20. Antiques, Classes A, B, C, D, E & F will have a speed limit, Must also use original Air Cleaner.
 - 21. Tractors pull in the order weighed in.

- 22. Consumption of alcoholic beverages prior to pull means disqualification.
- 23. Violation of any rule means disqualification.
- 24. Judges have the right to disqualify tractor for tampering with weights or operating in an unsafe manner.
- 25. Entry fee: \$10.00 per Class for the Tractor and \$5.00 per Driver.
- 26. Prize Money: 1st \$25.00, 2nd \$20.00, 3rd \$15.00, Plus trophies for 1st 3rd Places.
- 27. All Judges Decisions Final.
- 28. Any dispute over County residency will be settled by showing your drivers license. Show where land is in Plat Book. Proof of ownership of tractor. No drivers license, no pull.

RPM's due to flywheel concerns.

- 29. Open class must have blanket & bars.
- 30. Antiques and Open class are open to any one in state of Wisconsin.
